ICE SHOW:

Tentatively scheduled for April 1st, 2012.

All skaters at the CBS Skating Club are permitted in the ice show. Anyone who wishes to be in the ice show is required to fill out an ice show form. Ice Show forms will be available at our winter registration day in December. They will also be available in January on the website, at the skating office in the stadium and they will be handed out at a skating session in January.

There will be an Ice Show fee of \$35 that must accompany the ice show form.

This fee is used to help cover the costs of the following:

- ice time for practice, rehearsal and the ice show
- coaching fees for practice and rehearsal
- costumes, as provided by the skating club
- any other miscellaneous costs associated with holding the ice show

NOTICES:

Our **website**, www.cbsskatingclub.com, will be the primary means of communication for our members this year. It is the easiest way for us to get messages to all of our members.

You can supply an email address at registration, and we will email out notices when necessary, but sometimes group emails go to spam or bulk folders and are not always received by everyone. Sometimes notices will be handed out during skating, but if you are absent or leave early you may not get it.

It will be your responsibility to check the website for up-to-date notices and information.
