
To register you must have a new profile setup. It is a new system so you cannot use the one you had last year. You do not need your Skate Canada number to setup your profile.

- 10. If you get a Red Warning. You will not be able to proceed to the check out without fixing the problem (i.e., an Adult (over the age of 16) must register for the Parent and Tot program with their skater)





- 11. Ensure you have the right participant registered
- 12. You can delete a program if you made a mistake
- 13. You can register all members of your family for programs on the same invoice.

- 14. Once you have registered for all programs, you can review and click (Confirm & Register)
- 15. Update your billing information if different then the information you entered into your profile



- 18. You must read all policies and those with the asterisk(\*) are required to be accepted prior to completing your registration
- 19. Click preferred payment method. Credit Card or Confirm and Pay in Person. If you choose pay in person you will be required to bring cheque or cash the CBS Skating Club's Office at the Robert French Memorial Stadium. Payments can be made Wednesday, August 19 from 7:30-9:00 or on Monday, August 24 between 6:00-8:00pm. After this time if payment has not been received, your spot will be released.

- 16. If you have credits from last season they will be shown on your payment screen
- 17. Figure Skating programs can choose to pay all now or half program fees now and half on Sep  $30^{\text{th}}$  Skate Canada fees are all due at registration.
