The CBS Skating Club is pleased to announce open tryouts for our 2018-2019 synchro teams! Tryouts will be held at the Robert French Memorial Arena on Tuesday September 11, 2018 from 6-8pm. Tryout fees are \$10 per skater per session. All are welcome!

There will be two time slots – one for Beginner 1&2 at 6:00 and one for Adult 3 at 7:00. Please complete this form and return it to CBS.Team.Genesis@gmail.com as soon as possible. If you are out of town on that date, please note this on your form, we will let you know what to submit on a video for assessment.

As in prior years – if you skated on a team last year, you are requested to attend the session for that team, whether you intend to skate on that team again or not. This helps the coaches make comparisons to the new skaters!

Tell us what team(s) you are interested in: *(see the age requirements on the next page)* (if you don't select a team, don't worry, you will still be assigned to a tryout session based on your experience)

If you aren't selected for the above team(s), do you want to be considered for a team at another level? What level(s)? Basically, we're asking you to be honest about your goals and expectations! If you indicate you are only willing to skate at one certain level, and you don't make that team, or we don't have enough to field that level team, then we know not to offer you a spot on another team. The more information we have about what you want, the more we can do to help you be happy!

If your skill level and age is appropriate, are you interested in representing more than one team? This may mean skating up a level for a challenge, or skating down a level in order to pass along your knowledge and leadership. Please let us know what you may be interested in. *(If you are selected for two teams and subsequently decide to skate only one team, the decision on which team to "keep" will be at the discretion of the coach for age requirement and skill level reasons.)*

THIS QUESTION IS NOT APPLICABLE FOR BEGINNER SKATERS

If you were part of Team Genesis last year, you have earned the right to be on the Team again this year, provided you attend tryouts and accept your position! (subject to SC age requirements). You will be offered the HIGHEST level team (of the teams that we are able to field) for which your skill and age are appropriate. We do NOT hold back skaters in order to stack teams. However we may offer skaters the opportunity to double team on a higher level team as a stretch challenge in order to develop their skills. Double teaming gives you two years of experience in one year, making the higher team a possibility for you a year or two earlier than it normally would. We will clearly explain this again in the offer emails, should you be accepted to double team.

Skate Canada Synchronized Skating Age Requirements

BEGINNER 1	No minimum or maximum age, but 75% of the team must be born July 1, 2006 or later
BEGINNER 2	Must be born July 1, 2006 or later AND 75% of the team must be born July 1, 2008 or later
ELEMENTARY	Must be born July 1, 2003 or later
PRE-JUVENILE	Must be born July 1, 2006 or later
JUVENILE	Must be born July 1, 2003 or later AND 75% of the team must be born July 1, 2005 or later
PRE-NOVICE	Must be born July 1, 2000 or later, BUT no later than June 30, 2006
NOVICE	Must be born July 1, 2003 or later, BUT no later than June 30, 2008
INTERMEDIATE	Must be born July 1, 1999 or later, BUT no later than June 30, 2005
OPEN	Must be born June 30, 2003 or earlier
JUNIOR	Must be born July 1, 1999 or later, BUT no later than June 30, 2005
SENIOR	Must be born June 30, 2003 or earlier
ADULT 1	Must be born June 30, 2000 or earlier
ADULT 2	Must be born June 30, 2000 or earlier AND 75% of the team must be born June 30, 1993 or earlier
ADULT 3	Must be born June 30, 2000 or earlier AND 75% of the team must be born June 30, 1983 or earlier

This list is a complete list of all Skate Canada categories.

The club will <u>not</u> field teams at all levels, and the club may or may not field teams in the same levels as last year. As in prior years, team levels will be determined by the number, age, and skill levels of the skaters who try out.
